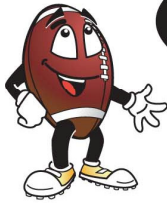
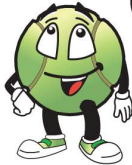


How to Play the Character Code Game



Student Team Warm-Up 10 Minutes

- Each team of students reads their Character Word, definition, and role-play situation on their card.
- As a team, come up with a solution to the role-play situation.
- Create a skit using all teammates to demonstrate the solution.



Game Time 15 Minutes

Each team of students:

- Read the Character Word, definition, and situation to the class.
- Perform the skit for the class.
- After the team presents the skit, answer questions about the skit and character word.



Optional Additional Game Ideas

Game Over

- As a class, re-read the Character Word definitions.
- Discuss what the words mean to the students and have them share a situation from their life in which they demonstrate the character word.

Daily Character Workout

- Challenge the students to practice the life skills and character words throughout the week.
- The Character Cards can be displayed in the classroom to remind the students what Character Fundamentals they are to be practicing.
